OBJECTION TO THE LOW ALTITUDE TACTICAL NAVIGATION (LATN) PROPOSAL

Resolution # 2010-31

- WHEREAS, the Pueblo of Picuris is a federally recognized sovereign Indian Tribe governed under a traditional form of government, consisting of a Governor and Tribal Council, and possessing all of the inherent powers of self-government; and
- WHEREAS, the Picuris Tribe has inhabited our traditional homelands for hundreds of years without interruption; and
- WHEREAS, the the Low Altitude Tactical Navigation (LATN) proposal would adversely affect the traditional kivas in the village; and
- WHEREAS, the Picuris Community has residents with medical conditions which would be negatively affected by the effects of the low-altitude flights; and
- WHEREAS, The Federal Code of Regulations prohibits unauthorized operation of aircraft at low altitudes – which is prohibited by the Endangered Species Act; and
- WHEREAS, the low-altitude flights would disturb all wildlife including the game which is hunted by Tribal Members in the Picuris forests; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Tribal Council of Picuris Pueblo strongly objects to the Low Altitude Tactical Navigation (LATN) proposal.

CERTIFICATION
